DECISION ON YOUR ACCESS APPLICATION

I refer to your application under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (FOI Act) received by ACT Health Directorate (ACTHD) on Thursday 15 October 2020.

This application requested access to:

“Australian Health Protection Principal Committee papers by or circulated to the Chief Health Officer, or their representative, between 1 May and 31 July 2020 concerning the following matters in Victoria:

- *Contact tracing*
- *Testing approaches*
- *Hotel Quarantine*
- *Elimination/suppression strategies*
- *Public Health workforce capacity.”*

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General of ACT Health Directorate (ACTHD) under section 18 of the FOI Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act. ACTHD was required to provide a decision on your access application by **Thursday 3 December 2020**.

I have identified 73 documents holding the information within the scope of your access application. This is outlined in the schedule of documents included at [Attachment A](#) to this decision letter.

Decisions

I have decided to:

- Refuse access to all 73 documents.

In reaching my access decision, I have taken the following into account:

- The FOI Act;
- The contents of the documents that fall within the scope of your request;
- Views of relevant third parties; and
- The *Human Rights Act 2004*.

Refuse Access

I have decided to refuse access to all 73 documents.

Public Interest Factors Favouring Disclosure

The following factors were considered relevant in favour of the disclosure of the documents:

- Schedule 2.1(a)(i) promote open discussion of public affairs and enhance the government's accountability;
- Schedule 2.1(a)(ii) contribute to positive and informed debate on important issues or matters of public interest.

Public Interest Factors Favouring Non-Disclosure

The following factors were considered relevant in favour of the non-disclosure of the documents:

- Schedule 2.2(a)(ii) prejudice the protection of an individual's right to privacy, or any other right under the *Human Rights Act 2004*;
- Schedule 2, 2.2(a)(ix) prejudice the flow of information to a regulatory agency;
- Schedule 2, 2.2(a)(x) prejudice intergovernmental relations;
- Schedule 2, 2.2(a)(xii) prejudice an agency's ability to obtain confidential information;
- Schedule 2, 2.2(a)(xvi) prejudice the deliberative process of government.

Prior to the COVID-19 outbreak, the Australian Health Protection Principal Committee (AHPPC) was a pre-existing body under the Council of Australian Government. When the National Cabinet for Australia's Coronavirus Response (National Cabinet) was established, documents prepared by AHPPC, including meeting minutes, were thereafter treated as Cabinet-in-Confidence.

All documents within the scope of your request include meeting papers which were designed to provide advice and guidance on the deliberative process of the AHPPC with State Governments and the Commonwealth Government. ACTHD is not the author of these documents but is privy to hold this information due to its representation at this Committee.

Additionally, consistent with section 38 of the FOI Act, Information Officers must take reasonable steps to consult with relevant third parties such as the Commonwealth before deciding to give access to information. As such, ACTHD conducted a consultation process across jurisdictions.

All documents include deliberative material and material communicated in confidence between governments in response to the coronavirus public health emergency. These meetings papers were drafted for the purpose of deliberations by the AHPPC and were communicated and recorded in a confidential forum. The release of this information could reasonably be expected to harm and damage the intergovernmental relationships between the ACT Government and other jurisdictions. On balance, I determined the information identified is contrary to the public interest and I have decided not to disclose this information.

Furthermore, the Secretary of the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet has written to the ACT Head of Service asking that the ACT consult with the Commonwealth Government about any National Cabinet material that is being considered for public release. Material prepared for and considered by the AHPPC which is in turn provided to the National Cabinet, or which are reflected in submissions AHPPC made to the National Cabinet, or in the deliberations or decision of National Cabinet, are treated as Cabinet-in-Confidence.

The ACT Territory Records Office has confirmed that National Cabinet documents do not routinely become ACT Cabinet documents unless they are presented to the ACT Cabinet however, not to subvert another jurisdiction's legislation, ACTHD considers that the release of this confidential and sensitive information would prejudice the intergovernmental relationship between the ACT Government, the Commonwealth Department of Health and the Victorian Department of Health and Human Services.

Charges

Processing charges are not applicable to this request.

Disclosure Log

Under section 28 of the FOI Act, ACTHD maintains an online record of access applications called a disclosure log. The scope of your access application and my decision will be published in the disclosure log not less than three days but not more than 10 days after the date of this decision. Your personal contact details will not be published.

Ombudsman review


