DECISION ON YOUR ACCESS APPLICATION

I refer to your application under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (FOI Act), received by ACT Health Directorate (ACTHD) on **Wednesday 13 December 2023**.

This application requested access to:

'A list of the name of all tenders for the last two years (1/1/2022 – 31/12/22 and 1/1/23 – 13/12/23) where the final decision maker was the Director-General, Chief Executive Officer.'

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General of ACT Health Directorate (ACTHD) under section 18 of the FOI Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act. ACTHD was required to provide a decision on your access application by **Friday 2 February 2024**.

The information has been extracted into one document holding the information within the scope of your access application. The document was created for the purpose of your request, with Procurement ACT being consulted for a manual review of possible documents.

Decisions

I have decided to grant full access to one document. The document released to you is provided as Attachment A to this letter.

In reaching my access decision, I have taken the following into account:

- The FOI Act; and
- The contents of the documents that fall within the scope of your request.

Charges

Processing charges are not applicable to this request.

Disclosure Log

Under section 28 of the FOI Act, ACTHD maintains an online record of access applications called a disclosure log. The scope of your access application, my decision and documents released to you will be published in the disclosure log not less than three days but not more than 10 days after the date of this decision. Your personal contact details will not be published.

Ombudsman review
