



Retrieval Registrars/Fellows 2017

The Capital Region Retrieval Service (CRRS) provides the medical crewing for the Snowy Hydro SouthCare Helicopter which is based in Canberra. The area of operations include both the alpine terrain in southern NSW, the arid south western plains and the south coast of NSW. All missions are crewed with a Paramedic and Doctor combination. Approximately 35% of our missions are pre-hospital and 98% of missions are rotary based. CRRS is accredited with ACEM, ANZCA and CICM as a special skills post for 6 months FTE. The term is for 12 months; 0.5 retrieval and 0.5 critical care specialty (ED, ICU or Anaesthetics) at the Canberra Hospital (Major Tertiary Trauma Centre). Full time positions will also be considered. Registrars can expect to work with a friendly and supportive team of Flight Paramedics, Rescue crewmen, Pilots and Retrieval Consultants, and be fully trained in all aspects of pre-hospital and retrieval medicine including winch rescue. We are looking for Registrars or Fellows for 2017 who are in the final 18 months of their ED, Anaesthetic or ICU training, have a reasonable level of physical fitness, enjoy working in physically challenging environments and have a strong sense of team work.
