Thank you for your email of 18 October 2019 regarding the location of the SPIRE Project on the Canberra Hospital Campus.

The SPIRE Project will be the largest healthcare infrastructure project ever undertaken in the ACT. It will deliver a bigger, better Canberra Hospital with more operating rooms, emergency treatment spaces and intensive care beds.

The location of the SPIRE Project was based on significant consultation and technical work to understand the best location for this new development. This included extensive consultation with clinicians, consideration of the space available on campus, the requirement for efficient linkages to other hospital services and the ability to keep all clinical services operational during construction. A core requirement of the project is that vital health services for the Canberra community are not disrupted during the building of the SPIRE Project.


This is a complex project which requires considerable planning and consultation to ensure we deliver the best possible outcomes. Ten clinical user-groups have been established that will direct and review the developing specifications and designs for the new facility. These include the Emergency Department, surgical and procedures areas and medical imaging.

I would like to assure you that the plans released are concept designs for the site and that consultation to date represents an early step in community engagement. We are committed to engaging with both our near neighbours and the greater ACT community to deliver a fit for purpose, state of the art facility that will provide vital services for our community, well into the future. The ACT Government is mindful of traffic pressures within the precinct and is keen to work with the community, including Garran Primary School and local residents, to address these as part of the broader planning process.

With regard to the Canberra Hospital Master Plan, I can advise that this work is expected to be complete in mid-2020. The Master Plan will complement SPIRE and look at important links between this building and the rest of the campus.
