☐ Functional/anatomical asplenia Extra vaccines required:

- Pneumococcal (Prevenar 13®) at 12 months
- Pneumococcal (Pneumovax 23®) at 4 years[¥]
- Influenza vaccine >6 months *†
- Meningococcal additional vaccines recommended but not funded under the NIP. Please discuss with a general practitioner or paediatrician.
- ☐ Immunocompromising conditions Extra vaccines may be required. Please consult a general practitioner or paediatrician.
- ☐ Other Chronic Conditions Extra vaccines may be required. Please consult a general practitioner or paediatrician.

Important notes:

* Influenza vaccine can be given from 6 months of age.

Two doses at least 4 weeks apart is recommended for children less than 9 years of age receiving the vaccine for the first time. Annual dose thereafter.

- † Fluvax (bioCSLtd) <u>must not</u> be given to children less than 5 years of age and is not recommended for children under 10 years.
- *Additional doses of Pneumovax 23® beyond the age of 4 years may be recommended, depending on ongoing risk. Consult a general practitioner or paediatrician.
