

# SMOKE-FREE PLAY SPACES

In the ACT, smoking is prohibited within 10 metres of children's play equipment in outdoor public play spaces.

Our children deserve play spaces that promote their healthy social, physical and mental development, free from passive smoke.

Police, Access Canberra Inspectors and City Rangers are authorised to enforce smoke-free play spaces.

Penalties of up to \$750 may apply for smoking in a legislated smoke-free area.
