Freedom of Information Request – FOI18-113

I refer to your application received by Canberra Health Services on 5 November 2018 in which you sought access to information under the Freedom of Information Act 2016 (the FOI Act).

In your application you have requested:

"A copy of the report/results of the investigation (swabs of the room sent to the Pathology team) conducted by the Infectious Disease Team on 22 February 2018 in NICU (Women's and Children's centenary hospital, the Canberra Hospital) bed space 3.33..."

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Chief Executive Officer under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act.

Canberra Health Services was required to provide a decision on your access application by 3 December 2018.

Decision on access

Searches were completed for relevant documents and one document was identified that falls within the scope of your request.

I have decided to grant access to the relevant document. The document released to you is provided at Attachment A to this letter.

Charges

Processing charges are not applicable to this request.

Online publishing – disclosure log

Under section 28 of the Act, ACT Health maintains an online record of access applications called a disclosure log. Your original access application, my decision and documents released to you in response to your access application will be published in the ACT Health disclosure log not less than three days but not more than 10 days after the date of this decision. Your personal contact details will not be published.

Ombudsman review

My decision on your access request is a reviewable decision as identified in Schedule 3 of the Act. You have the right to seek Ombudsman review of this outcome under section 73 of the Act within 20 working days from the day that my decision is published in ACT Health's disclosure log, or a longer period allowed by the Ombudsman.
