COVID-19 Stage 2A Access Restrictions

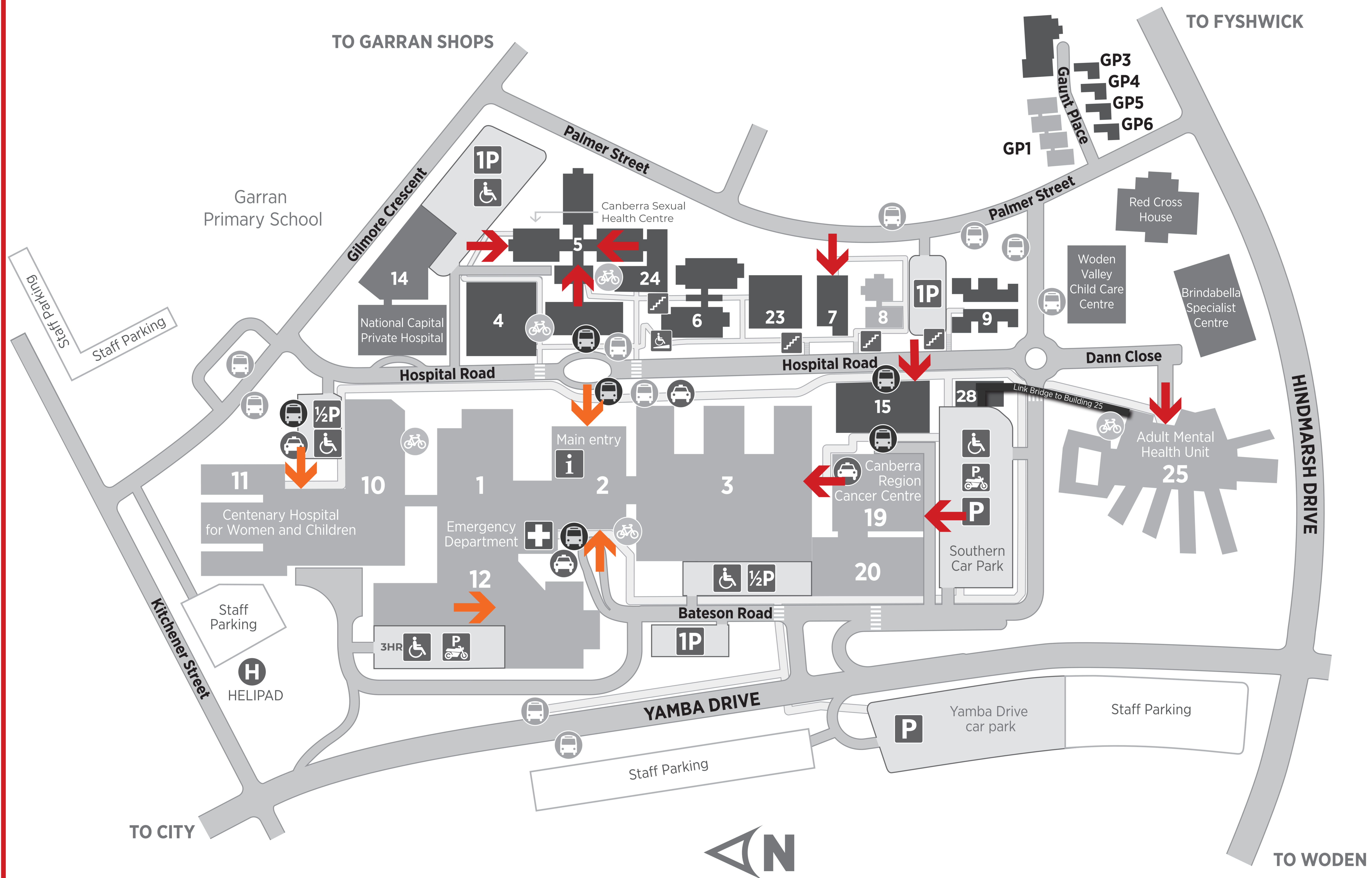
Visiting times for all buildings remain at 6am to 9pm. After hours please use the intercom to gain access.
