## **DECISION ON YOUR ACCESS APPLICATION**

I refer to your application under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (FOI Act), received by ACT Health Directorate (ACTHD) originally on **Tuesday 20 September 2022** and rescoped on **Monday 26 September 2022**.

The rescoped application requested access to:

"I request all documents / correspondence held by the Ministerial & Governance Services (MAGS) and the Local Health Network (LHN) for Question On Notice 805"

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General of ACT Health Directorate (ACTHD) under section 18 of the FOI Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act. ACTHD was required to provide a decision on your access application by **Tuesday 15 November 2022**.

I have identified 38 documents holding the information within scope of your access application. These are outlined in the schedule of documents included at <u>Attachment A</u> to this decision letter.

# **Decisions on access**

I have decided to:

- grant full access to 13 documents; and
- grant partial access to 25 documents.

My access decisions are detailed further in the following statement of reasons and the documents released to you are provided as <u>Attachment B</u> to this letter.

In reaching my access decision, I have taken the following into account:

- The FOI Act;
- The contents of the documents that fall within the scope of your request;
- The views of relevant third parties; and
- The Human Rights Act 2004.

# **Full Access**

I have decided to grant full access to 13 documents at references 4-5, 7-8, 12, 18, 21, 25-28, 30 and 38.

## **Partial Access**

I have decided to grant partial access to 25 documents at references 1-3, 6, 9-11, 13-17, 19-20, 22-24, 29 and 31-37. Redactions have been made to information that I consider, on balance, to be contrary to the public interest to disclose under the test set out in section 17 of the Act as the information contained in these folios are partially comprised of personal information.

## <u>Public Interest Factors Favouring Disclosure</u>

The following factors were considered relevant in favour of the disclosure of the documents:

- Schedule 2, 2.1(a)(i) promote open discussion of public affairs and enhance the government's accountability;
- Schedule 2, 2.1(a)(ii) contribute to positive and informed debate on important issues or matters of public interest;
- Schedule 2, 2.1(a)(iv) ensure effective oversight of expenditure of public funds; and
- Schedule 2, 2.1(a)(viii) reveal the reason for a government decision and any background or contextual information that informed the decision.

## Public Interest Factors Favouring Non-Disclosure

The following factors were considered relevant in favour of the non-disclosure of the documents:

• Schedule 2, Schedule 2.2 (a)(ii) prejudice the protection of an individual's right to privacy or any other right under the *Human Rights Act 2004*.

On balance, the factors favouring disclosure are outweighed by the factor favouring non-disclosure as the information would not provide any government information pertinent to your request. The personal information is of both ACT-Government and non-ACT Government employees' contact details and has not been disclosed as this could reasonably be expected to prejudice the protection of the individual's right to privacy. Therefore, I have determined the information identified is contrary to the public interest and would not advantage the public in disclosing this information.

## Charges

Processing charges are not applicable to this request.

# **Disclosure Log**

Under section 28 of the FOI Act, ACTHD maintains an online record of access applications called a disclosure log. The scope of your access application, my decision and documents released to you will be published in the disclosure log not less than three days but not more than 10 days after the date of this decision. Your personal contact details will not be published.

## **Ombudsman review**

My decision on your access request is a reviewable decision as identified in Schedule 3 of the FOI Act. I have some concerns that there is an agreed process for responding to QON whereby the LHN will calculate the territory-wide responses and provide them to CPHB for authority to release the data. The exception to this is where ACTH does not hold the relevant data. We are trying to understanding the numbers below, there was a expansion to the maternity ward completed approximately July 2018 which brought the beds from 15 to 18.

Would you mind sending us the methodology used to calculate the beds please. In the table below, Calvary has used physical bed capacity of 3S only which does not necessarily reflect funded bed capacity which would be used if you are calculating occupancy. In 2018, the refurbishment of the maternity ward actually reduced physical bed capacity of beds in 3S by modifying 4 bed rooms to 2 bed rooms and only the fact that 3S now had access to the repurposed space from closed ward 3SG, that increased bed capacity. These changes were made in response to ACT women preferring the modern space and layout of the wards at Centenary Hospital for Women and Children. At this time 3S only had a funded bed capacity of 15 beds from April 2016 until February 2021 when additional funding was sourced to fund an additional 3 beds.

For CPHB to answer the question on notice accurately, we should have also included physical bed capacity from the reclaimed 3SG space and also included the wards, Birth Suite (BS), Birth Centre (BC – this is the Continuity of Midwifery Care Service) and Maternity Assessment Area (MAA).

I had a conversation with Meg Bransgrove and corrected the record on outstanding QON. I also talked about the increasing number of multidimensional questions being asked of Calvary: a hospital under capacity challenges and with no MAGS team equivalent.

Could the team have a think about the circumstances/questions that might prompt us to ask Calvary in advance how much time they anticipate answering questions might take and then Margaret you have a conversation with Meg in advance of Calvary embarking on responding where the data/answers are not immediately available.

Meg is happy to discuss with Minister in what circumstances she might wish to respond that answering a certain question would unreasonably divert resources.



Hi Sinead - please find attached the updated clearance including Maternity ward methodology detailed by Mick Barnes.

I was able to find the relevant MDC codes Mick was using to calculate maternity separations, however the reference data we hold in the Data Repository only includes up to DRG version 9 ( which was superceded on 1 Jul 2020). For that reason, its likely the data from 2020-21 is not entirely accurate. I have flagged this issue with our Repository team to address. Otherwise, all methodology I have used Is in line with Mick's specifications.

For some reason, there is still a discrepancy between my and Mick's code. I would recommend using his response for this question, but I would like to do a complete review of all the data I've included in the attached extract.





Hi Sinead - please find attached the updated clearance including Maternity ward methodology detailed by Mick Barnes.

I was able to find the relevant MDC codes Mick was using to calculate maternity separations, however the reference data we hold in the Data Repository only includes up to DRG version 9 (which was superceded on 1 Jul 2020). For that reason, its likely the data from 2020-21 is not entirely accurate. I have flagged this issue with our Repository team to address. Otherwise, all methodology I have used is in line with Mick's specifications.

For some reason, there is still a discrepancy between my and Mick's code. I would recommend using his response for this question, but I would like to do a complete review of all the data I've included in the attached extract.







I have some concerns that there is an agreed process for responding to QON whereby the LHN will calculate the territory-wide responses and provide them to CPHB for authority to release the data. The exception to this is where ACTH does not hold the relevant data. This process was developed as being the most efficient methodology so that reporting teams do not waste limited resources trying to replicate each other's logic and to acknowledge that neither party sets out to provide inaccurate figures or to discredit each other but can spend an inordinate amount of time re-working data.

We welcome the new Data Analytics Branch management of the data responses, but want to ensure that the agreed processes remain in place. We encourage early dialogue where assistance is requested.

Thank you for this information.

We are trying to understanding the numbers below, there was a expansion to the maternity ward completed approximately July 2018 which brought the beds from 15 to 18.

Would you mind sending us the methodology used to calculate the beds please. In the table below, Calvary has used physical bed capacity of 3S only which does not necessarily reflect funded bed capacity which would be used if you are calculating occupancy. In 2018, the refurbishment of the maternity ward actually reduced physical bed capacity of beds in 3S by modifying 4 bed rooms to 2 bed rooms and only the fact that 3S now had access to the repurposed space from closed ward 3SG, that increased bed capacity. These changes were made in response to ACT women preferring the modern space and layout of the wards at Centenary Hospital for Women and Children. At this time 3S only had a funded bed capacity of 15 beds from April 2016 until February 2021 when additional funding was sourced to fund an additional 3 beds.

For CPHB to answer the question on notice accurately, we should have also included physical bed capacity from the recialmed 35G space and also included the wards, Birth Centre (BC – this is the Continuity of Midwifery Care Service) and Maternity Assessment Area (MAA).

I've pulled up all the Admissions with a Birth Diagnosis code (ICD Code 238) since 2016 and the following wards are listed as recording Births; 238.% will only be looking at births from the babies perspective so will give the wards that a baby "was admitted to" all of those admitted outside NU and NQ would have been clerical errors. If you wanted to use similar methodology to find wards where women who gave birth were admitted you would use Z37.% which will provide you with the mother's perspective. This is how you should be looking at questions relating to Maternity and birth services.





Hi Sinead - please find attached the updated clearance including Maternity ward methodology detailed by Mick Barnes.

I was able to find the relevant MDC codes Mick was using to calculate maternity separations, however the reference data we hold in the Data Repository only includes up to DRG version 9 (which was superceded on 1 Jul 2020). For that reason, its likely the data from 2020-21 is not entirely accurate. I have flagged this issue with our Repository team to address. Otherwise, all methodology I have used is in line with Mick's specifications.

For some reason, there is still a discrepancy between my and Mick's code. I would recommend using his response for this question, but I would like to do a complete review of all the data I've included in the attached extract.
